<u>Supervisor's Update</u>	7:15 p.m.	Inform parents of program updates	Mrs. Bailey explained that the position of gifted and specialty programs supervisor was split. She is now the supervisory of gifted education. In the ETD program, teachers are introducing 2 nd grade strategy games. Gifted staff partnered with Bookworm Central to match games with cognitive skills, especially skills tested in aptitude tests in 2 nd grade, to give all students exposure to the type of thinking tested. She also shared that the NNAT will be taking place at 6 th and 9 th grades. Mrs. Bailey shared information about the Virginia Association for Gifted conference in Richmond in October that is offering sessions for parents. She also invited parents to the professional development about twice exceptionality on Oct. 24.
